

Library Against Liberty

In order to conduct a forum "on Fair and Safe Sport for Girls," <u>Moms for</u> <u>Liberty</u> reserved and paid for a room at a library.

Then, the librarians ambushed them.

Yolo County Public Library Regional Manager Scott Love "<u>invited disruptive protesters</u>" to the August 2023 forum and then shut it down as soon as it started. He disagreed with Moms for Liberty that men who demand the right to participate in women's sports are men. So the matter couldn't even be discussed. Not in the library's reserved and paid-for meeting room.

With the help of the Institute for Free Speech and

Alliance Defending Freedom, Moms for Liberty <u>sued</u>, arguing that Yolo County Library had acted unconstitutionally.

According to the <u>complaint</u>, "Defendants are not required to agree with Plaintiffs' views about protecting women's sports. The First Amendment, however, requires that Defendants allow Plaintiffs to speak freely about the integrity of female athletics in library meeting rooms. It demands public library officials not enable — let alone participate in — the disruption and cancellation of Plaintiffs' events on account of their viewpoints.

"The Court should hold Defendants accountable for the damage they caused in censoring Plaintiffs' event and ensure that such censorship never happens again."

The library has now settled, revising its policies to (we hope) protect the freedom of speech of patrons who use its meeting rooms. It must also pay plaintiffs \$70,000 in damages and legal costs.

Sadly, those funds come from taxpayers. Seems Mr. Love should pay a price.
